

COIN DROP EVENTS

These are events where the pinball machines at the museum accept coins to play. This is how the museum operates every day.

There is no time limit on how long you can run your event like this (During museum hours, extra fees apply for outside museum hours).

There are no fees for running an event like this.

The museum will continue to operate as normal whilst an event like this is in progress (Still open to the public, see “Extras” section for private event pricing).

Museum tokens are available for purchase. Organisers can bulk buy tokens at a discounted rate for their event. Pricing is further down in this document.

FREE PLAY EVENTS

All pinball machines and video games at the museum on **UNLIMITED FREE PLAY** for a maximum of **THREE HOURS**

| Number of people | Base Cost | Price per person |
|------------------|-----------|------------------|
| 1 - 5 | \$150 | \$25 |
| 6 - 30 | \$200 | \$20 |
| 31 + | \$300 | \$20 |

All pinball machines and video games at the museum on **UNLIMITED FREE PLAY** for **ALL DAY** (11am – 9pm)

| Number of people | Base Cost | Price per person |
|------------------|-----------|------------------|
| 1 - 5 | \$300 | \$25 |
| 6 - 30 | \$400 | \$20 |
| 31 + | \$600 | \$20 |

- Base cost is to be paid 7 days before the event date.
- The organiser can chose whether the museum collects the \$20 admission fee or if the organiser collects the \$20 from each person and then buys the wristbands from the museum.
- Wristbands provided to keep track of who has paid admission.
- No partial refunds if less than the estimated number of attendees arrive.
- If more than the estimated number of attendees arrive, the next tier of “base cost” will apply.

SINGLE MACHINE FREE PLAY

This is an ideal setup for online streamers or a party only wanting to play a couple of machines for the duration of their event.

No limit on the number of people playing the games, but a maximum of 5 pinballs can be selected.

A pinball machine is chosen to be set to UNLIMITED FREE PLAY. The rest of the machines at the museum will still accept coins to play.

| Number of hours | Number of machines | Cost per pinball | Cost per video game |
|-----------------|--------------------|------------------|---------------------|
| < 3 | 1 | \$40 | \$30 |
| < 3 | 2 - 5 | \$30 | \$25 |
| All Day | 1 | \$80 | \$50 |
| All Day | 2 - 5 | \$60 | \$40 |

Extras:

Extended Hours: Request the museum to be open earlier or later than normal trading hours (11am to 9pm) - **\$40 per hour.**

Outdoor trestle tables: Price is for entire duration of event - **\$5 per table.**

Museum Tokens: For coin drop events, organisers may want to provide their attendees with coins, for this the museum can provide tokens for play. Old games cost 1 token per game, new games cost 2 tokens per game. Discounted rates apply as follows -

| Number of tokens | Cost |
|------------------|-------|
| 50 | \$50 |
| 200 | \$180 |
| 1000 | \$850 |

Free internet access - This is shared internet with other museum guests. For a dedicated internet connection - **\$30 per day.**

Tournament management software: Museum staff can provide the software, provide setup and show you how to use the tournament software. - **\$50 per tournament.**

Tournament scorekeepers and management. We can provide staff that will manage the usage of the tournament software for you and can verify and enter all scores obtained during the tournament. Note that the number of scorekeepers will vary depending on the type of tournament.

| Number of attendees | Estimated # of staff | Cost per 3 hour block |
|---------------------|----------------------|-----------------------|
| < 30 | 1 | \$100 |
| 31 + | 2 | \$200 |

Private event: Closing fee so that we close the doors to the general public allowing for a completely private pinball event. To be organised a minimum of 60 days in advance and paid 30 days in advance.

| Number of hours | Cost |
|-----------------------|--------|
| < 3 | \$400 |
| All Day (11am to 9pm) | \$1000 |
